

Host Organisation Requirements for FISO World Level Events

This guide should be used for World and Continental Events

Since host capabilities vary, this guide provides a basis on which to form an event host contract. Rights, obligations, support, fees and rights are flexible and may be negotiated.

Organising the world level events ("Events") under World Obstacle, the Fédération Internationale de Sports d'Obstacles ("FISO", including world cups, world series, and world championships, is a joint effort between the host, the Local Organising Committee ("LOC") and FISO.

Revenue Generating Rights of the LOC

For the organising rights fee, the LOC receives revenue generating rights and receives 100% income from:

- National television broadcast
- National media (including web and mobile rights)
- National marketing including all advertising and promotion of goods and/or services outside of the FISO Protected Categories
- National sponsorship generated by the Organiser in any category (commercial sector/ local and regional government)
- Value in kind sponsorship
- Spectator ticket sales

FISO Support Provided to the LOC

FISO allocates the rights fee to deliver and cover the following services:

- FISO's event knowledge and services, including support from FISO staff
- Provision of external consultancy on TV broadcasting
- Provision of information and guidelines for competition rules and guidelines
- Assistance with establishing and reinforcing the relation between the LOC and National Sports Federations
- Rights Fee €100,000

Obligations of the LOC

- Provide accommodation / board (student-level) for international athletes, coaches, supporting staff and officials attending the Event. This may include discounts or be fully covered by the LOC
- Cover all on-site technical/organisational costs related to the staging of the Event
- Run the competitions operations under the supervision of FISO in accordance with the FISO guidelines and requirements
- Provide a clean international television signal or streaming service for FISO international broadcast
- Follow FISO guidelines and criteria for Code of Ethics, Anti-doping, Safety, Medical and Event Production.
